

### PE and School Sport Funding

In the academic year 2015 – 2016 the school was allocated £8851 in PE Premium funding. It was our intention to use this to provide a range of CPD to support teachers in providing high quality teaching and learning experiences for all pupils. We also intended to increase access to a broader range of curricular and extracurricular events to promote physical activity and school sports and engage more children in participating in sports festivals and competitions. We will also looked to further improve access to sports facilities through installing a multi-use games area.
